# WHAT DOES THE LIBRARY LOOK LIKE?



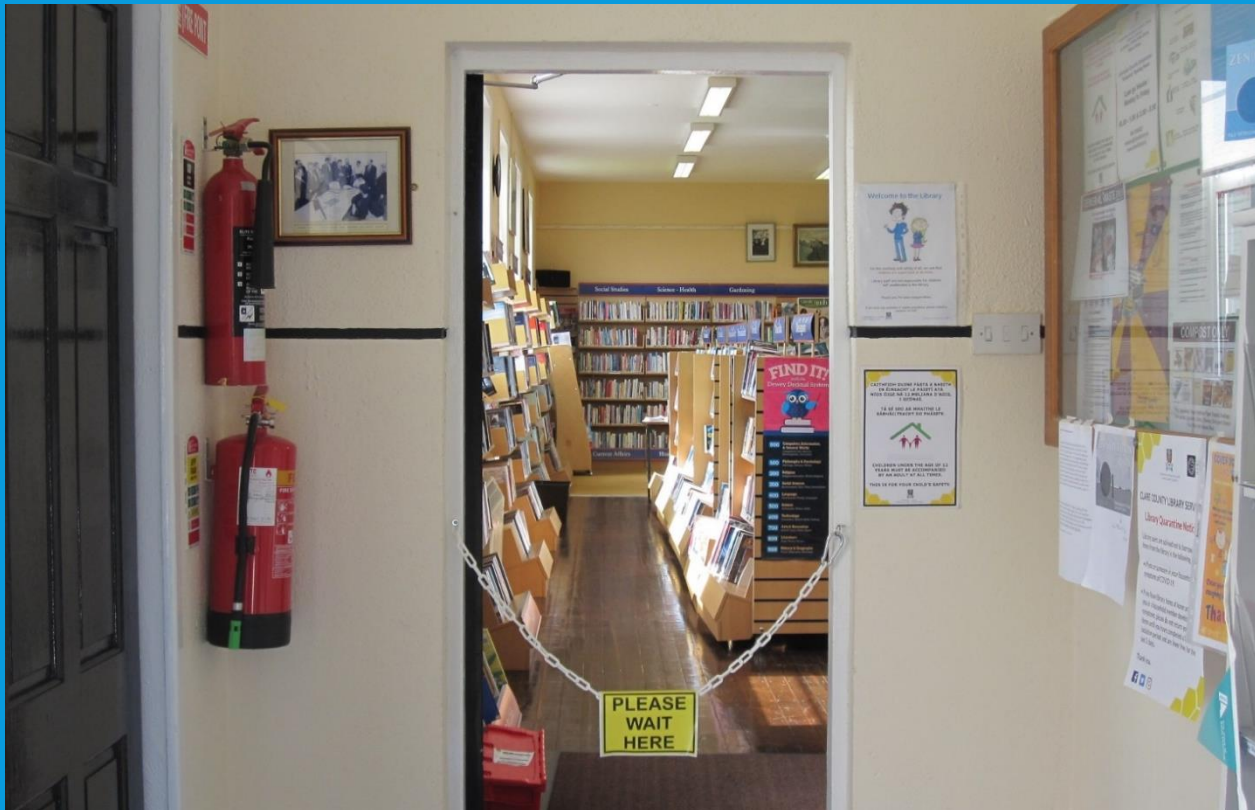
- This is what the outside of the library looks like

- There are always lots of nice colourful book displays in the library for me to choose a book from.

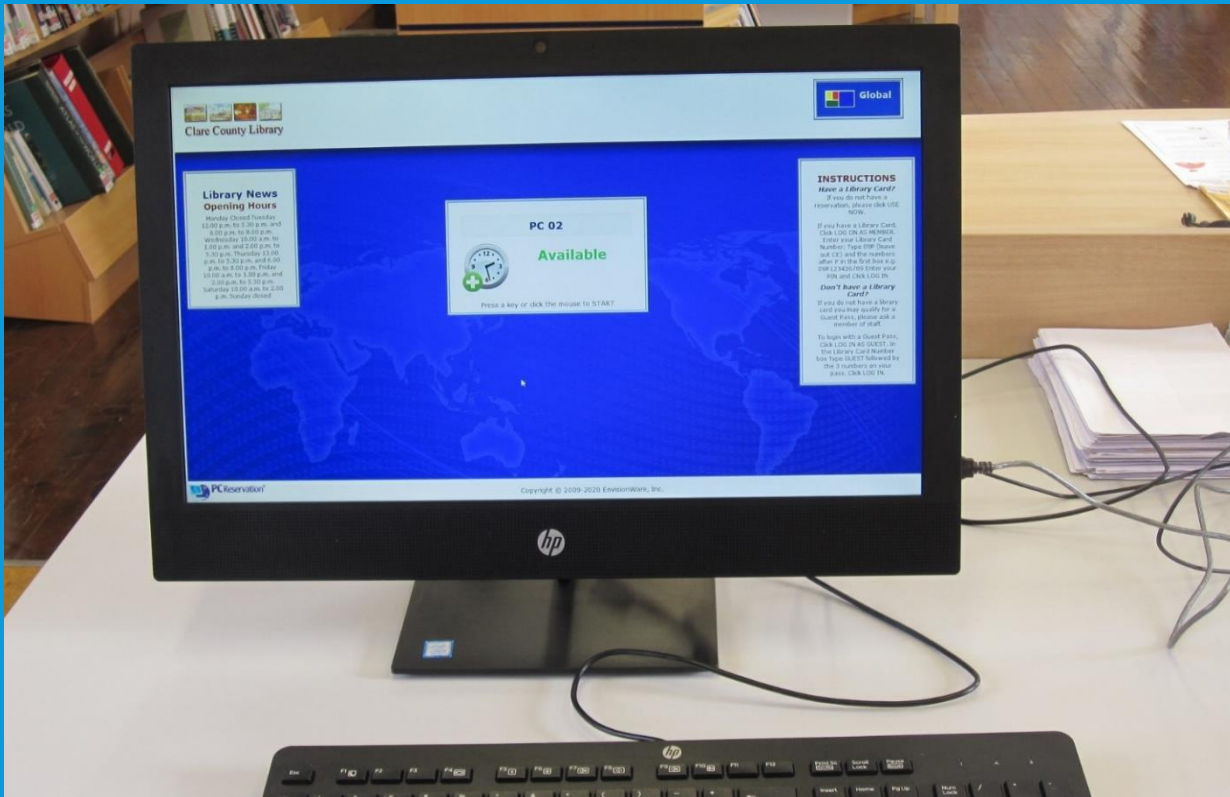
# HOW DO I BECOME A MEMBER OF THE LIBRARY?
